



Enrico de Santis was born in Rome in 1970, he has a law degree, studied art in Rome, London, New York and Milan, where he lives. He is a professional journalist, an NPS Nikon photographer, a member of the National Association of Italian Photographers. Enrico De Santis' work as a photographer started when, while being a skipper of a vintage sailing ship, he first sent his photos of world's best seas and nature to many magazines. From that time, Africa became his home continent and art his food. On important events, he is an enduring reporter for international photo agencies and, in Italy, for the biggest newspaper in the country, Corriere della Sera. His best reportages cover people's reactions against mafia in Calabria; wild nature and scientific efforts in Galapagos and South Africa; ecology growth in Himalaya and Andes; archaeological hidden and secret treasures in underground Naples and Rome. Mainstay for years of *Viaggi del Sole*, Enrico De Santis nowadays works in Italy and abroad for several magazines such as *Sette*, *Dove*, *Gentleman*, *Ladies*, *Capital*. He also works for CIPSI (Coordination for Popular Initiatives of International Solidarity) for which he photoshooted African women to support the campaign for the Nobel Peace Prize for African Women in 2011
